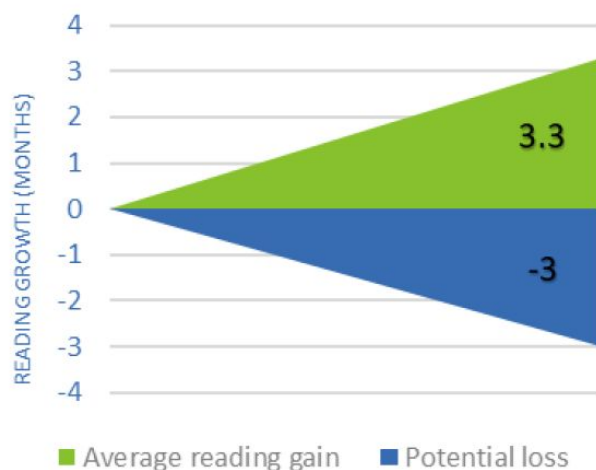

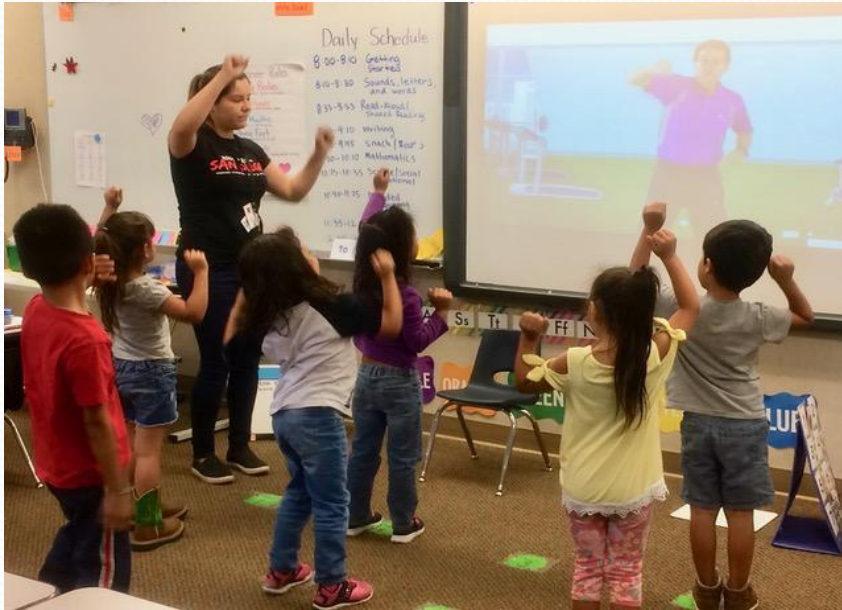
Summary

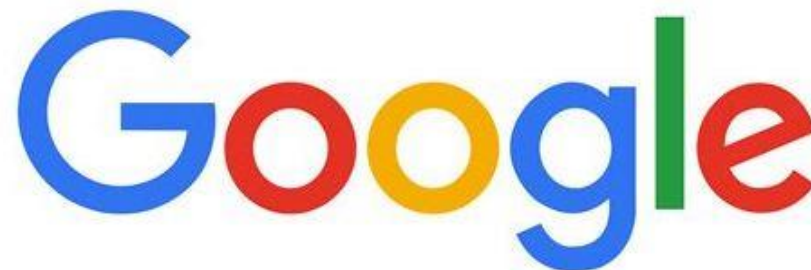
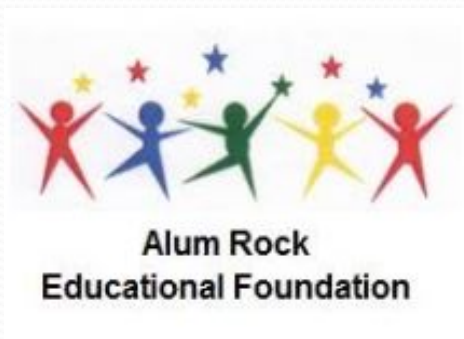
