


# Survey Results - OVERALL ALL Stakeholders









# Survey Results – SUPPORT FOR ACADEMIC LEARNING










#### Survey Results-SAFETY









# Survey Results - SCHOOL CONNECTEDNESS







#### Considerations

### SUPPORT FOR ACADEMIC LEARNING

- 1. Explore opportunities for increased after school student interventions at school sites (ie. high school/college tutors)
- 2. Study possibilities for providing additional enrichment opportunities for students (ie. Summer, STEAM, VAPA, Coding)
- 3. Continue with development of SEL program for increased student support
- 4. Consider ways to incorporate a wide- range of technology apps/platforms as learning tools.

#### **SAFETY**

- 1. Build out of District SEL Plan
- 2. Development of positive school culture practices (i.e culture awareness & celebration of diversity)
- 3. Build on strategies for alternatives to school suspensions
- 4. Maximize intern and counseling support at school sites

### SCHOOL CONNECTEDNESS

- Providing intentional professional development for parents
- Build capacity for meaningful parent engagement including a plan for advertisement and outreach to parents about school events
