School Resource Officers provide the following direct services to ARUSD:

- ❑ Campus Security for 5 middle schools
- ❑ Mentoring services to youth
- ❑ Serve on the School Attendance Review Board (SARB)
- ❑ Assist schools/administrators in triaging emergencies
- ❑ Provide Safe escort service to our students at our annual Cesar Chavez March

School Resource Officer Roles

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- ❑ Work closely with students to establish positive relationships.
- ❑ Establish and maintain a close partnership with school administrators in order to provide for a safe school environment.
- ❑ Assist school administrators in emergency crisis planning and building security matters.
- ❑ Provide a course of training for school personnel in handling crisis situations, which include Run, Hide & Defend training.
- ❑ Be visible within the school community. Attend and participate in school functions. Build working relationships with the school's staff as well as with student and parent groups.
- ❑ Initiate interaction with students in general areas of the school grounds and building. Promote the profession of police officer and be a positive role model.
- ❑ School Resource Officers are mandated to go through a 3 hour long training through the School Liaison Department before permitted to work in the school environment.
